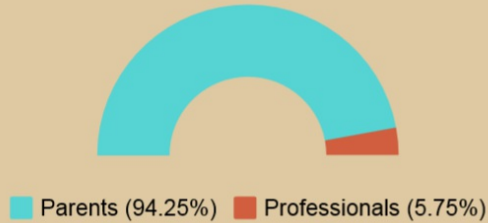

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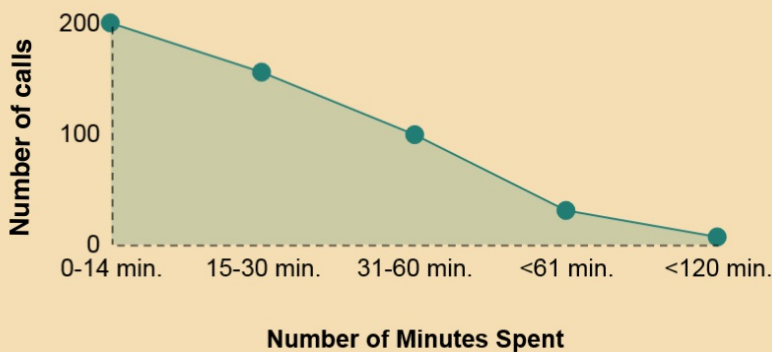
# 2015-2016 Executive Summary of Accomplishments

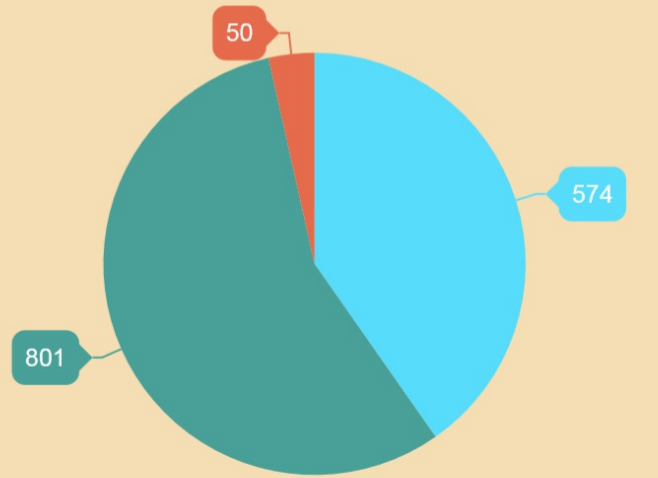
## Individual Intakes: 487 total



## Time Spent on Parent Calls



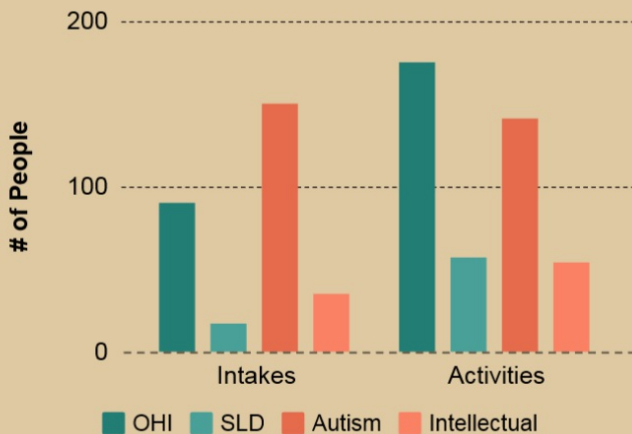
## Roz Completed 158 Activities Impacting 1,425 Participants



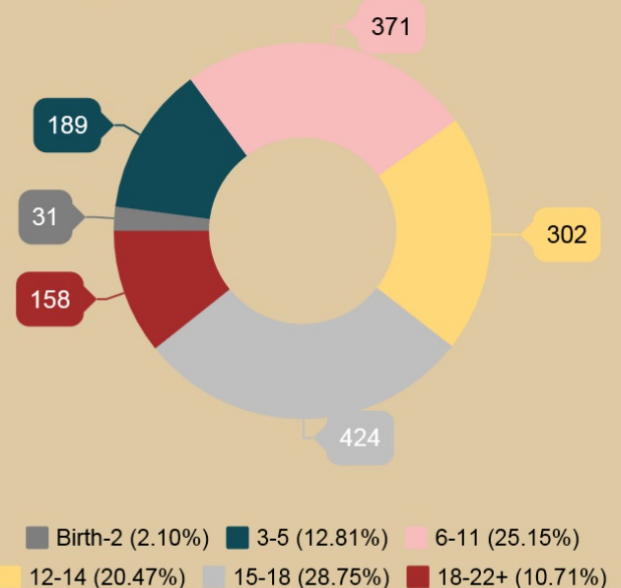

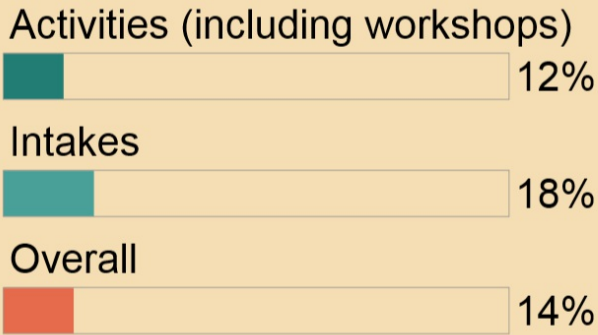
## Top Disability Categories for Intakes and Activities

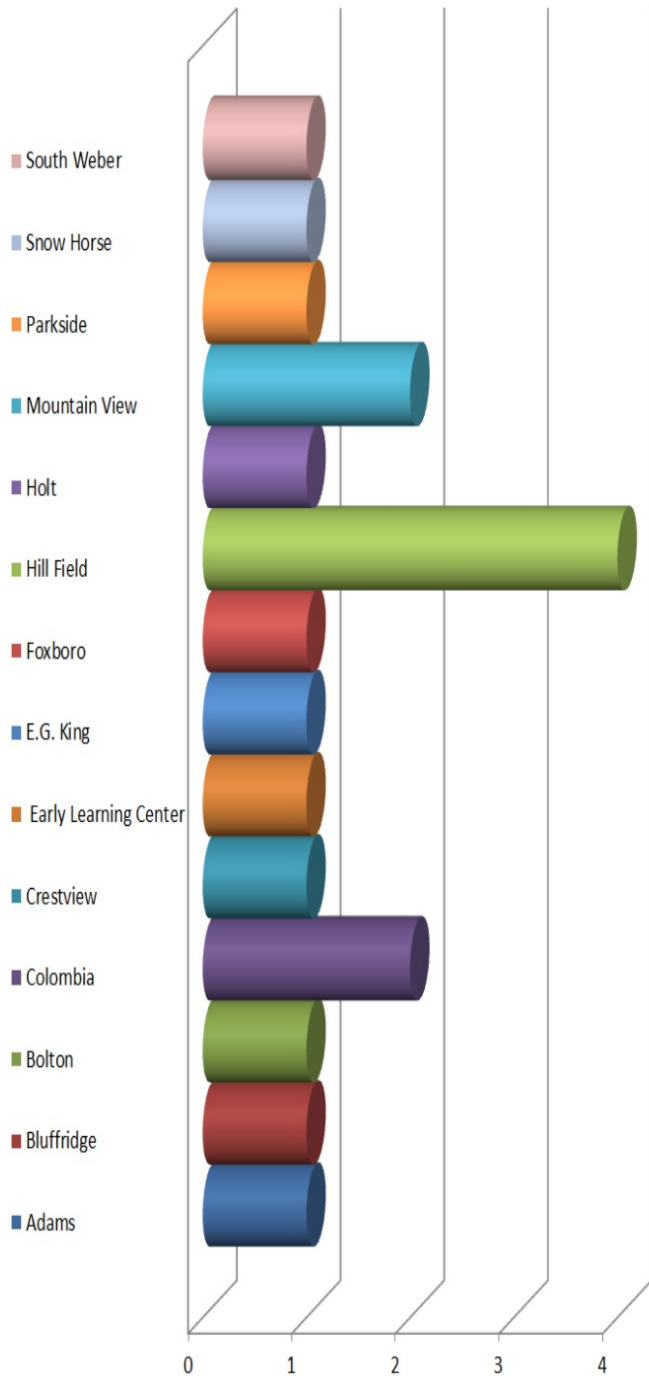

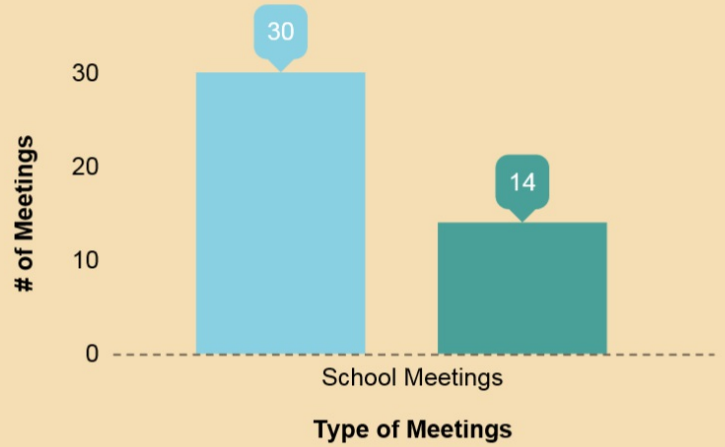

# 2015-2016 School Meeting Data

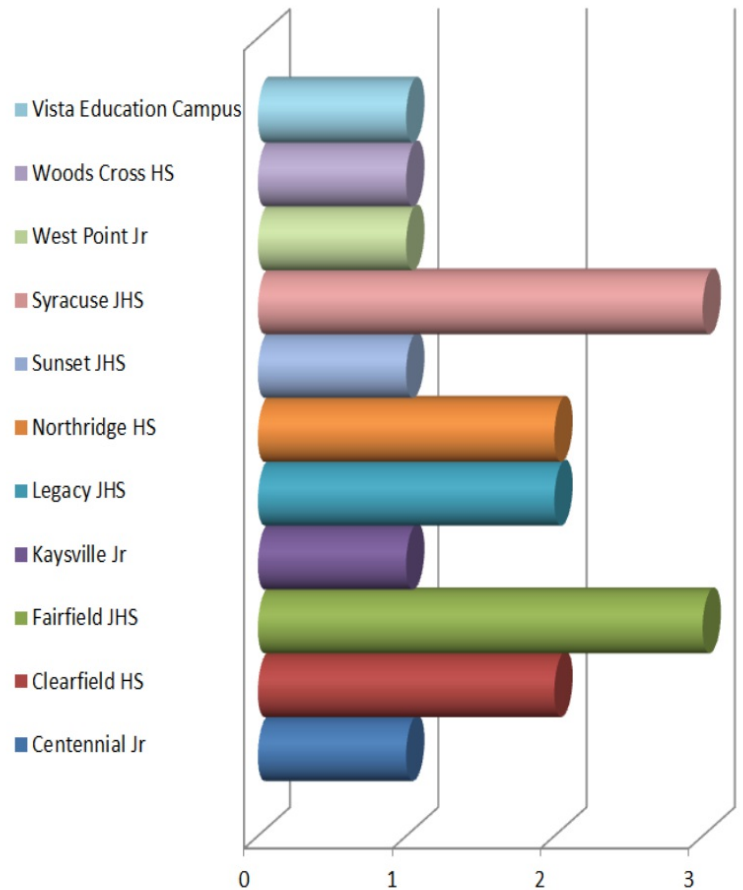
## Elementary Schools
